5th Thule Expedition was initiated and organized by Knud Rasmussen and took place 1921-1924 in Canada and Alaska with a small trip to the eastern most tip of Russia. The Knud Rasmussen Archive is located in Frederiksværk about 70 kilometers north of Copenhagen. The archive is closely linked to the Knud Rasmussen House in Hundested (www.knudrasmus.dk), where Knud Rasmussen lived the last years of his life.

The primary focus for the archive is Knud Rasmussen's activities connected to the trade station in Thule in the period 1910-1933. The registrant, "INDSIGT. Nr. 8. Knud Rasmussens Papirer" covers most of the archive. However, records submitted in recent years are not present in the registrant – ask the archive.
